For Your Safety:

- Be alert for snakes, stinging insects and poisonous plants
- Wear leather shoes or boots, a hat and safety glasses
- Wear clothing that will not divert attention of motorist during cleanup activities
- Wear clothing that will not impair vision or movement during cleanup activities
- Work in small groups
- Face oncoming traffic when picking up litter and look up often to ensure that no vehicle is encroaching your work area
- Stay well clear of construction
- Stop working in bad weather, especially when there is poor visibility and wet or icy roads

How does the Adopt-A-Road Program Work?

Adopt-A-Road groups agree to:

- Adopt a road for a minimum of 2 years
- Select an available segment of county road at least one mile in length
- Pick up litter at least twice a year
- Purchase signs to mark the section.
- Call the office and inform them of where your filled bags are located after pick-up

Manistee County Road Commission will:

- Provide trash bags
- Remove filled bags from the roadside
- Remove large, heavy or hazardous items from your adopted segment
- Erect signs that recognize your group's cleanup efforts

YES You Can.

Did you know that anyone can help adopt a road?

With just a few minutes of your time and \$50 you can adopt a road. It is a one page application that just asks a few questions. Once you adopt a road it only requires a commitment of twice a year. Then after you have your road segment picked-up, Just fill out the pick-up report and send it back into the Manistee County Road Commission office to keep your section.

You can get anyone to help you, get a club, a group, or just go for a walk with friends.

Your supplies are provided for you. Stop by the Road Commission to get your bags and vests!
